



STUDENT CONTRACT

I confirm that the Study Programme I have agreed to, as set out in the Learning Agreement, is suitable. It takes into account my previous academic performance, my interests, progression opportunities and the courses available to me. I understand that I must maintain a minimum programme size throughout my college studies. The advice I have been given at admissions and enrolment interviews and in the written information provided has been satisfactory and appropriate to my needs.

As a student at the College, I agree to abide by the following five key commitments:

1. I will be responsible and considerate in and out of lessons and show respect to all members of the College community, including local residents, in order to promote a supportive and friendly environment that enables effective learning to take place.

I will not be in possession of, distribute or be under the influence of a substance (illegal drugs, legal highs or alcohol) or be in possession of substance associated paraphernalia while on the College campus, or within the surrounding community, during the College working day or while engaged in College related activity, and understand, that any such offence would constitute a gross misconduct intervention.
5. I will have my ID Card on my person at all times while engaged in College activity and produce my ID card if required to do so by a member of staff.

In signing this document, I understand and accept my responsibilities as a student as set out in the Student Contract and the Code of Conduct, including the Health and Safety Agreement and the IT Code of Conduct. I accept that if I break this contract I may be liable to disciplinary action, or in extreme cases be asked to leave the College.
