



## **Your Course Interview**

#### What is it?

- All Applicants are required to complete a Course Interview.
- You will receive an invite by email with a date and time, two weeks before the scheduled interview.
- Interviews take place November to April, between 3:30 and 5:30pm.



#### **The Interview**

- A 15-minute video call on Microsoft Teams with a teacher.
- You will need to provide your GCSE target grades.
- An opportunity to ask questions.
- Choose your Taster Day choices

# After your Course Interview

- You will be sent a formal offer by email.
- Login to your online applicant account to accept your place within two weeks of receiving the offer.
- Our Taster Days are on Friday 3 and Monday 6 July 2026
  - attend taster sessions and confirm a provisional study programme.
- **Enrolment**, 24-26 August 2026
  - confirm your study programme.



## **Entry Requirements**

- 5 GCSEs grade 9-4 (A\*-C for iGCSEs)
  - minimum requirement to secure your place.
- Vital to achieve at least a grade 4 or above in GCSE English Language.
- Very important to achieve a grade 4 or above in GCSE Maths.
- Some subjects require specific grades at GCSE (e.g. Maths, Sciences & Modern Languages).
- Importance of good GCSE results
- Firm foundation for success at A Level and BTEC.
- Universities will look at your GCSE grades.
