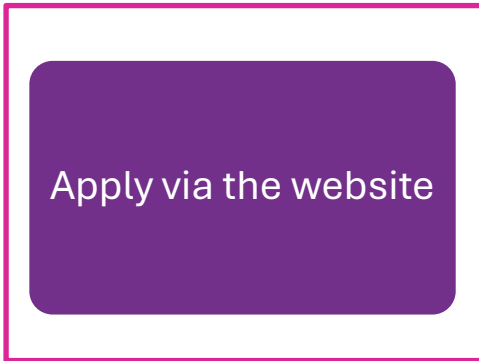


College Context

- Large mainstream campus
- 2300 students
- Students come from over 120 schools in Surrey and SW London
- Level 3 provision only – A Level & Vocational courses
- All students do 3 courses

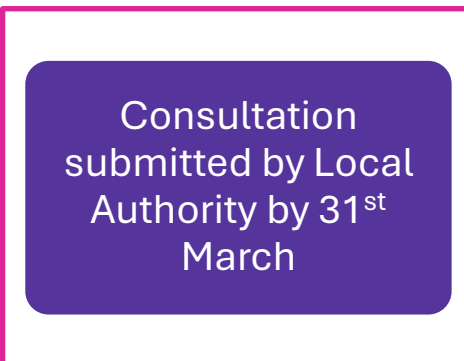
How do I apply to ESFC as an applicant with an EHCP?

Part 1*



Receive a guaranteed offer subject to successful completion of a consultation

Part 2*



Consultation is between Local Authority and College



College consults on whether we can meet the needs in the EHCP

College suggests amendments to Section F that would allow us to meet needs

Consultation concluded and ESFC named in Section I of EHCP

Student enrolls subject to meeting the College entry requirements

***BOTH** parts of the process must be completed for us to proceed

Consultations

- We are sent the EHCP and review Section F
- We will indicate what we can and cannot provide in our context
- The EHCPs we receive tend to be very aligned with school or non-mainstream provision so we may suggest amendments to fit our provision
- If the Year 11 Annual Review occurs prior to the consultation, it is beneficial to consider the Section F in light of the support offered at ESFC



What transitional support is available?

- Once you have applied via the website, you can book a **tour of the College**. They run twice weekly in the **autumn and spring term**. Each tour consists of 5 students and a parent.
- All applicants have an **online interview**
- All applicants with an EHCP will be offered a **transitional meeting** in June with the ALN Department
- All applicants attend **Your Start at Esher** day in July
- All students with an EHCP are offered a meeting with the Director during enrolment
